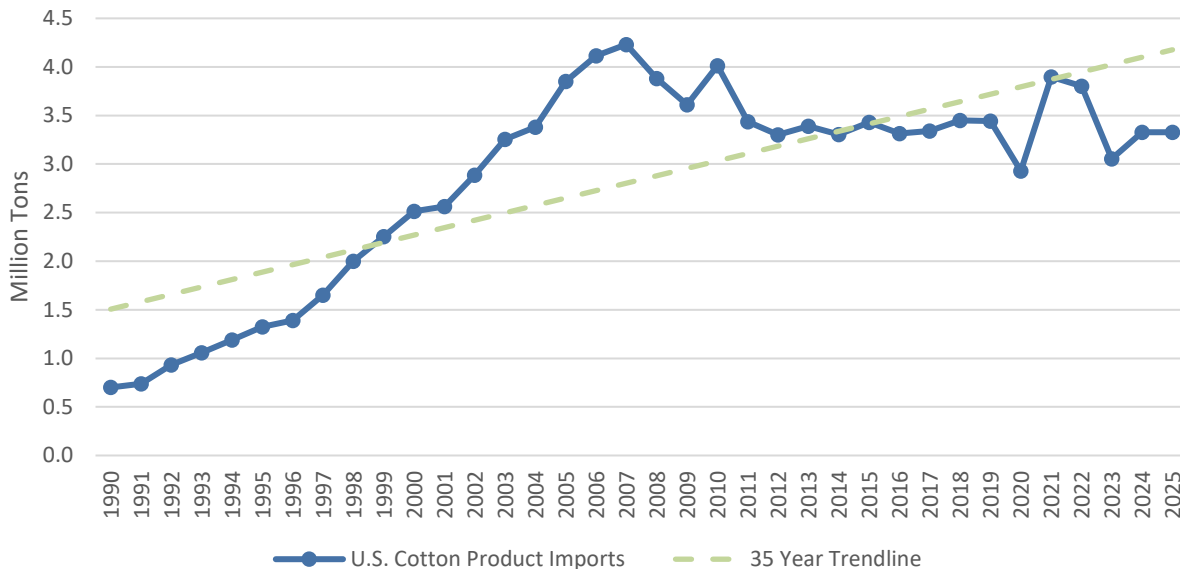


Cotton: World Markets and Trade

2025 U.S. Cotton Product Imports Flat

The United States is the world’s largest importer of [cotton products](#) (i.e., apparel, home textiles, etc.) and most U.S. consumer retail purchases of these goods are imported¹. Cotton product imports in calendar year 2025 were flat at 3.3 million metric tons (tons), roughly equal to the 15-year average.

The U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis estimated that U.S. real Gross Domestic Product (GDP) increased 2.2 percent in 2025, partly driven by an increase in consumer spending. [Retail sales](#) at clothing stores in the United States are estimated to have risen 5 percent to a new record.² Despite strong consumer demand, flat imports suggest retailers drew inventories lower to minimize costs related to the fluid tariff environment. In contrast, European Union cotton product imports increased 13 percent to 3.1 million tons in 2025 despite economic growth of just 1.4 percent (according to the International Monetary Fund). EU imports increased sharply in the last 5 years to rival the United States, driven by increased shipments from Bangladesh and Pakistan.

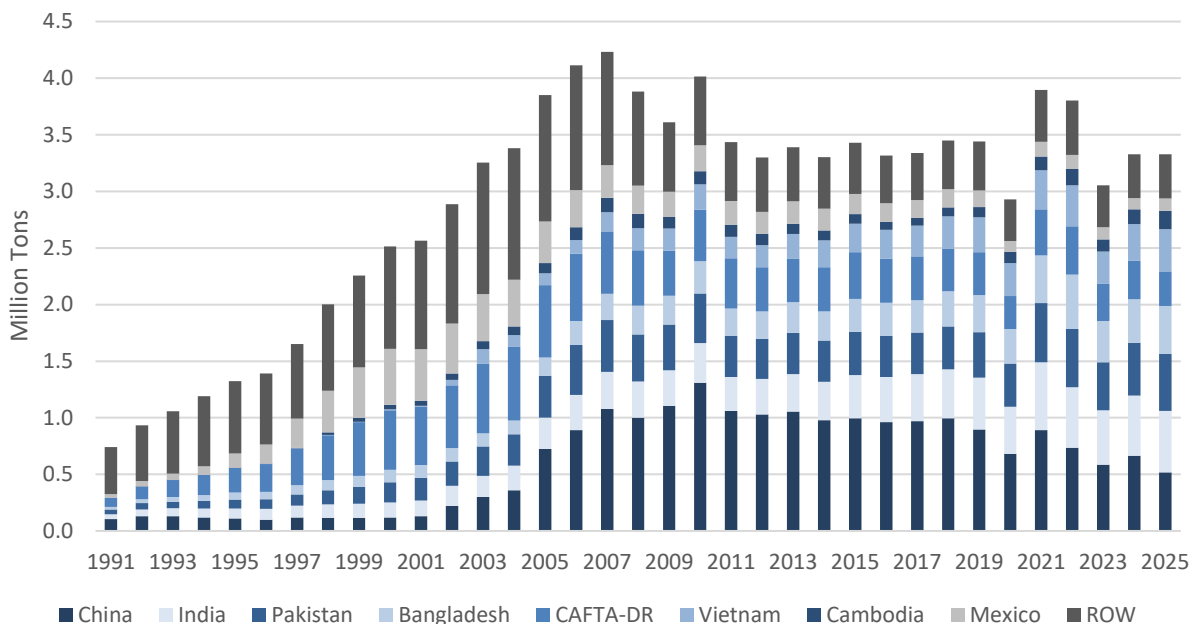
Cotton product imports remain below historic levels due to competition with man-made fiber (MMF) products. According to a recent International Cotton Advisory Council World Textile Demand Report, cotton’s market share in global fiber consumption fell below 25 percent in recent years from nearly 40 percent in the early 2000s. This limits the potential growth for cotton product imports despite record consumer demand for apparel and home textiles. Competition with MMF products is especially challenging with respect to Chinese MMF product exports. U.S. cotton

product imports from China dropped 60 percent since peaking in 2010, while MMF product imports rose nearly 40 percent during the same period.³

While the volume of U.S. cotton product imports was flat in 2025, India displaced China as the largest supplier. India benefits from a vertically integrated textile supply chain that enhances firms' ability to comply with traceability standards. In contrast, firms have been lessening their dependence on China due to the Uyghur Forced Labor Prevention Act (UFLPA) and the perception of increasing geopolitical risk, which has expanded to include tariff uncertainty. In 2025, the United States announced several rounds of tariffs on China that ranged from 10 to 125 percent. While other countries also had varying levels of tariffs applied throughout the year, they were less than half of the highest rate applied to China. These conditions allowed India and other suppliers – including Vietnam, Bangladesh, Pakistan, Mexico, and Cambodia to expand market share in the United States.

In 2026, U.S. cotton product imports are expected to rise because of low retailer inventories and stable consumer demand. Changing trade policies will continue to influence from what countries these cotton products are sourced.

2025/26 Outlook

Global production is forecast up over 1.1 million bales to 121.0 million as larger crops in Brazil and China more than offset a smaller crop in Argentina. Global consumption is forecast down more than 100,000 bales to 118.6 million as reduced demand in Pakistan, Bangladesh, Mexico, and

Vietnam more than offset higher demand in China. While global production is up 2 percent year over year, consumption is down slightly.

Global trade is raised 200,000 bales to 43.9 million on higher exports from Australia. Higher imports for India more than offset lower imports for Pakistan, Bangladesh, and Vietnam.

Global ending stocks are raised nearly 1.3 million bales to 76.4 million as higher ending stocks in India and Brazil more than offset lower ending stocks in Australia and Argentina.

The U.S. season-average farm price for 2025/26 is projected unchanged at 60 cents per pound.

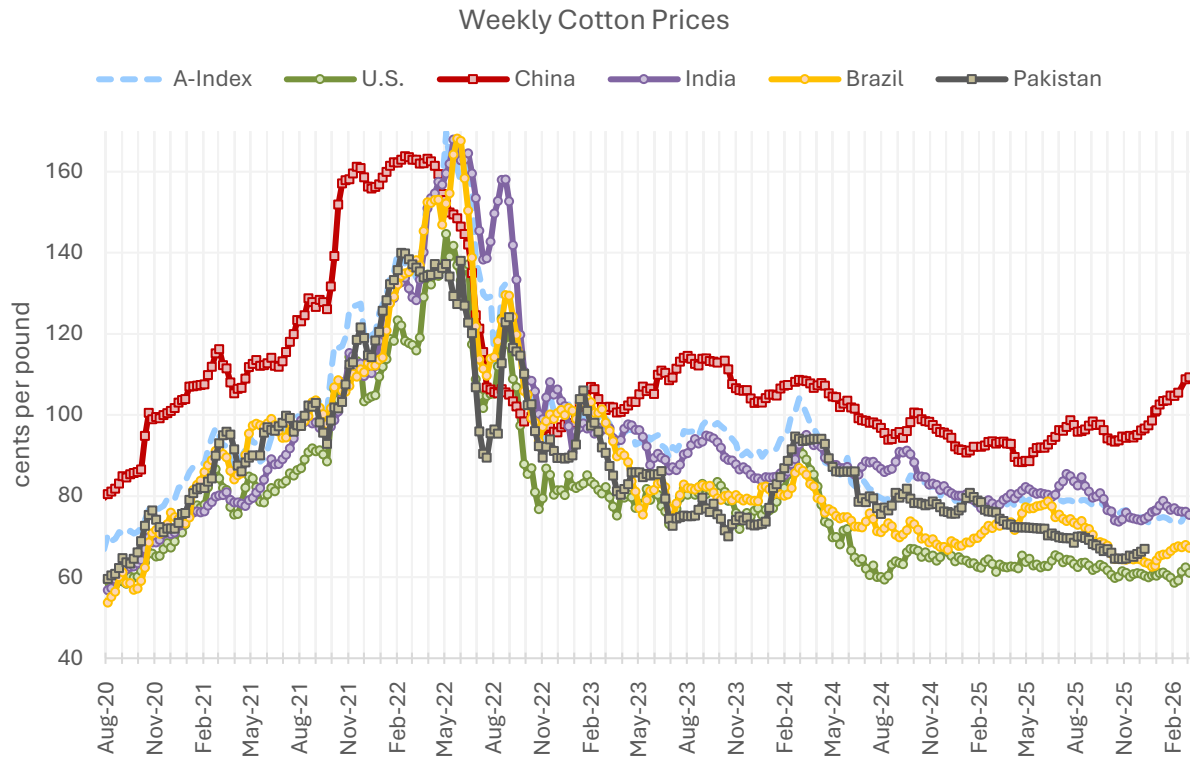

Futures and Spot Prices

Since the last WASDE report, cotton futures on the Intercontinental Exchange (ICE) have risen to around 64 cents per pound.

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Notes on Price Series

A-Index is published by Cotton Outlook and reflects the average of the five cheapest quotations (quality being middling 1^{1/8} inch) of upland cottons traded internationally; the delivery price reflects Cost and Freight (CFR) to a Far Eastern Port.

U.S. is the simple average reported by the Agricultural Marketing Service, Free On Board (FOB) car/truck across seven U.S. spot markets of grade strict low middling.

China is the reported China Cotton Price Index (i.e., CCIndex 3128B) and reflects the national weighted average of middling grade cotton; the delivery price is at the textile mill in China.

India is the Shankar-6 (middling grade 29-3.8-76) spot price and is reported ex-gin (at the gin yard) in Gujarat.

Brazil is strict low middling and reflects the delivered price to a mill in São Paulo.

Pakistan is the ex-gin (at the gin yard) price in Karachi reflecting a 1^{1/16} inch staple and grade 3.

Production, Supply, and Distribution (PSD) Attributes for Cotton

(Note: Area Harvested is reported in thousand hectares and all other attributes in thousand 480-lb bale equivalents.)

Marketing Year: August – July, for example, the 2024/25 marketing year is August 1, 2024 – July 31, 2025.

Area Harvested: The area of land planted to cotton from which seed cotton is harvested.

Beginning Stocks: The quantity of cotton lint physically located within a country on August 1 (the first day of the marketing year, for example, August 1, 2023 of the 2023/24 marketing year) and includes cotton lint in transit. Beginning stocks equal the ending stocks of the previous year.

Production: The quantity of cotton lint ginned from harvested seed cotton during the marketing year and does not include cotton [linters](#) (short fibers attached to cottonseed).

Imports/Exports: The quantity of cotton lint physically imported into or exported from the country during the respective marketing year. This includes the Harmonized System (HS) code specific to the four-digit heading 5201 (Cotton, not carded or combed) and specific to unprocessed cotton lint. For some countries, imports include cotton bales in bonded warehouses that have *and* have not cleared customs.

Domestic Use: Also referred to as cotton consumption or mill use. All cotton lint that has been processed during the marketing year and excludes cotton linters. Domestic yarn production (100% cotton fiber or cotton blended with other fibers) usually accounts for more than 90 percent of domestic use. Yarn production occurs at a spinning mill and hence is also referred to as “spinning”. Use outside of yarn production typically includes nonwoven fabric production (see [nonwoven products](#)).

Ending Stocks: The quantity of cotton lint physically located within a country on July 31 (the last day of the marketing year, for example, July 31, 2024, of the 2023/24 marketing year) and includes cotton lint in transit. Ending Stocks will always equal the following year’s beginning stocks.

Loss: Cotton that has been destroyed or cannot be accounted for. Loss may also include “negative loss” when the estimates of Ending Stocks exceed the difference between **Total Supply** and total use (total use is equal to **Exports** plus **Domestic Use**).

Other Terminology

Cotton Textiles: Refers to both the yarn and fabric industries. This mostly pertains to spinning mills (yarn manufacturers), weavers (woven fabric manufacturers), and knitters (knit fabric manufacturers).⁴

Cotton Products: Refers to end-use products including apparel and home goods (e.g., towels and bed sheets) as well as [nonwoven products](#) (e.g., medical and hygiene products). When referencing “cotton product” trade data, certain imports are not included that contain cotton fiber. Circular analyses include HS (Harmonized System) codes that specify cotton as the primary fiber and typically state “of cotton” in the product code description.

Garment Manufacturers: Typically reflects cut-and-sew and finishing operations to assemble and produce the final end-products such as apparel (i.e., cotton products).

Example of a Cotton Supply Chain

Cotton planted [**Farm**] → Cotton harvested [**Farm**] → Cotton ginned to separate lint from seed and compressed into bale (represented as Production in the PSD) [**Gin**] → Cotton bales spun into yarn or fibers processed into nonwoven products (represented as Domestic Use in the PSD) [**Spinning Mill**] → Yarn woven or knit into fabric [**Fabric Mill**] → Fabric is dyed and processed [**Fabric Mill**] → Finished fabric is cut-and-sewn into apparel or other finished product [**Garment Manufacturer**] → [**Retailer**]
